On October 9, 2015, the status was changed from Undergraduate Program of Dentistry, Faculty of Medicine, Universitas Brawijaya, to Faculty of Dentistry, Universitas Brawijaya, by Letter of Approval from Minister of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucracy Reformation No. B/3278 / M.PAN-RB/10/2015.

COLLABORATION IN ACADEMIC FIELD

CREDIT TRANSFER PROGRAM

- ICT is a higher education internationalization program initiated by the The Republic Indonesia by taking courses at partner universities overseas as a program that supports the independent campus learning policy.
- Transferred credits can combine courses, final assignments, fieldwork practices, and practical field experiences.
- The number of credits obtained by students is equivalent to 6–20 credits. Conducted online and offline

- The Indonesian International Student Mobility Awards is a scholarship program offered by the Republic of Indonesia to assist Indonesian students in mobility programs at prestigious universities worldwide.
- Undergraduate students spend one semester (four to six months) at a partner university abroad, taking courses unrelated to their major, developing leadership and intercultural communication skills, immersing themselves in local culture, and broadening their global network.





3in1 Fakultas Kedokteran Gigi Universitas Brawijaya

- A program in the learning process of specific subjects that is not only handled by full-time lecturers in Universitas Brawijaya but combined with part-time recruitment of international-quality foreign lecturers and practicing lecturers
- One course is managed by three lecturers: UB lecturers, foreign lecturers (professor or associate professor), and practitioner lecturers.


RESEARCH FOCUS & ROAD MAP

The development of research and community service in Faculty of Dentistry ((FKG) regulated by the Unit for Research and Community Service (BPPM). In 2016, BPPM has determined the topics that will be the focus of research at FKG, including:

- Wound and Bone healing (regeration)
- Stem cell and nano dental material
- · Herbal medicine
- Social medicine

Based on the interaction of the four focused research topics, a research roadmap related to bone regeneration was prepared, starting from studying the pathology (causes and mechanisms) of several factors (disease and social) that cause bone defects/resorption, developing interventions using drugs or herbal remedies, searching biomarkers for the development of medical devices, which ultimately results in rational/ novel treatment for bone defects/resorption according to the cause.

RESEARCH GRANTS

Collaborative research grant funds can come from:

- (1) Faculty: FKG offers funding for the Join Research competitive scheme for researchers who conduct research with FKG UB partner national and international universities. The deadline for accepting proposals is the first week of March
- (2) The University Brawijaya (UB): International Collaborative Research Grant (HAPKI) is the implementation of the MOU that Brawijaya University has signed. The requirements for research members must include foreign research partner researchers from institutions that already have an MOU with UB. The deadline for accepting proposals is the first week of February
- (3) University PTNBH, Indonesian Collaborative Research (RKI) is the research between university PTNBH, PTNBH with BRIN, and PTNBH overseas. The strategic fields developed must contain a multi-, inter-, and cross-

disciplinary approach, preferably having local Indonesian content (indigenous knowledge and resources), and aims to help solve local problems in Indonesia. The deadline for accepting proposals is the fourth week of March.
